Xenia, OH – Greene CATS Public Transit Marks its milestone 20th year of service on January 8, 2021 with free rides on its Flex Route thanks to Family & Youth Initiatives (FYI) who will be paying the fares for riders. Since 1978, FYI has been empowering families and providing hope with multiple programs including:

- Parenting Network -Pregnant and new families get training, pre-natal assistance, diapers, clothes, and other necessities through its Baby Bucks program
- Real Life ... Teen Choices - Classroom instructors work in schools in six counties, reaching 5,000 students on forming relationships and protecting from abuse
- The Mentoring Program - Pairs at risk children who need an adult volunteer to listen and provide a solid example on how to navigate in society
- Gardening for Health - Get out of the house this spring and put your green thumb to work growing vegetables to share with the community or for your table.
